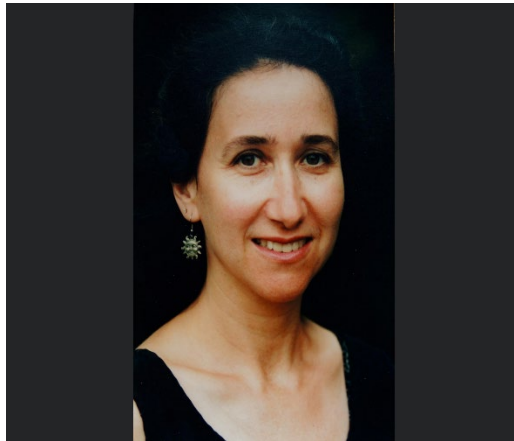


OBITUARY
